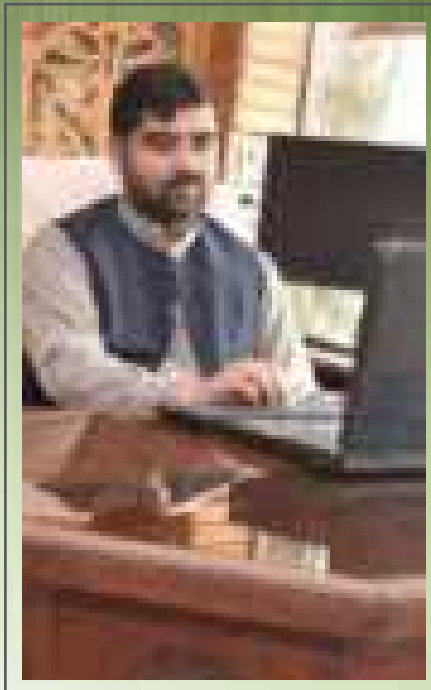

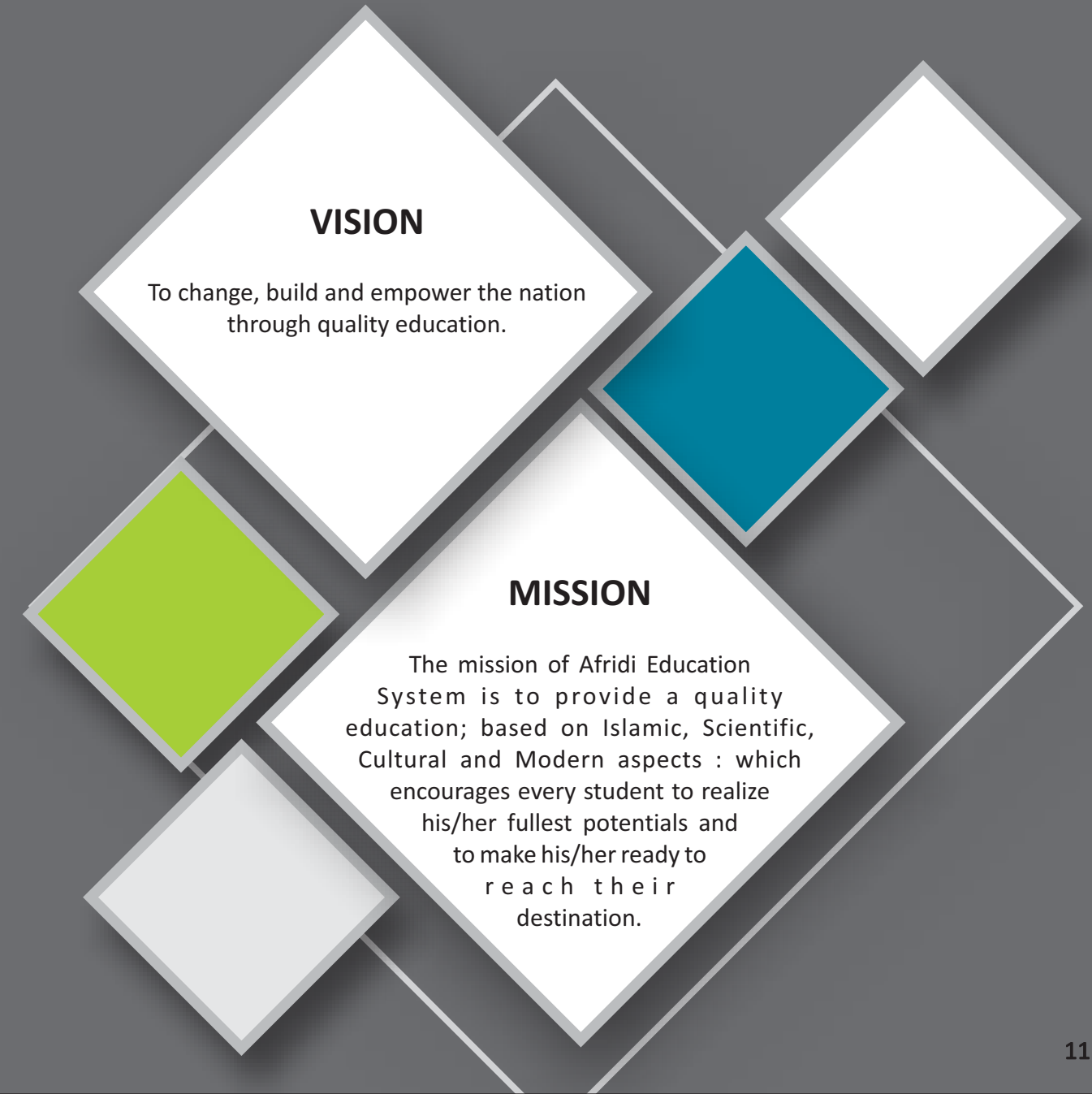

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission process will be completed as per schedule advertised.
2. Late admission cases shall be dealt with strictly in accordance with the Peshawar Educational Boards/Universities rules or until such a date fixed by the Principal.
3. Registration is must before appearing & Entry test .
4. Each student will have to appear in an objective type entry test /subjective or in both.
5. Students placed in grade “B” or above will be preferred for admission.
6. Candidates belonging to Board other than the BISE Peshawar must produce migration certificate along with their admission forms or within one month of admission.
7. Any student, involved in any misconduct or unlawful activity during the admission period or tried to interfere in the admission procedure shall be ineligible for admission.
8. No admission form, under any circumstances, shall be considered for any category except for which it has been submitted in by the candidate before the closing date for admission.
9. The students promoted to next class / semester shall not be allowed to attend the class until they deposit all their dues.
10. Father/ Guardian must accompany his son/ward on the day of Admission / interview, otherwise admission will not be granted.

Note: The admission forms will be considered incomplete if the above documents are not attached therewith.



RULES CONCERNING FEE AND OTHER DUES

- Fee is payable for twelve months of the year by all students. Tuition fee is payable from September to next August for college student and from April to March for School Students .
- Fee once deposit will not be refundable.
- The name of student whose fee remains unpaid for consecutive three months is automatically struck off the School/college roll.
- For Re-admission Rs.4000/ as Re-admission Fee plus other dues with fine are to be paid.
- Roll Numbers for Board /University Examination are issued only when a student clears his/her dues and has the required number of attendances to his/her credit.
- The above mentioned rules may be altered by the Principal when required for the benefit of the institution.
- School students will have to pay their fee at the start of every month.
- College Students will have to pay their fee according to the prescribed procedure in fee structure.

- c. Pre-Board at the start of March



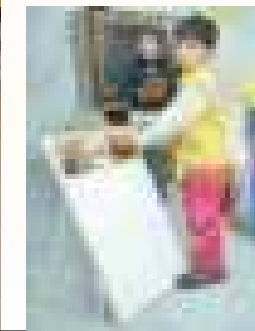
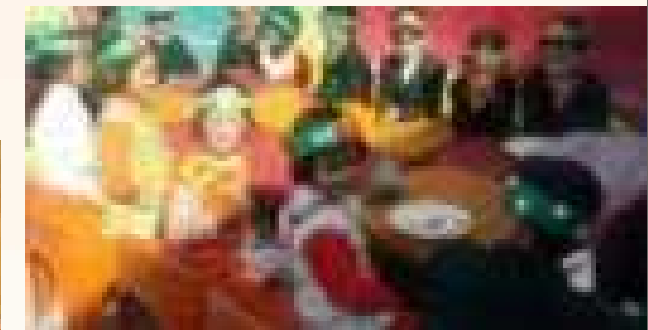
NOTE:

IDENTITY CARD

AES issues identity card to all students at the commencement of regular classes every year. They are required to display their cards at all the time. Refusal to display the card can entail a fine. In case of misplace of card, a duplicate will be issued on payment.



CLASS ATTENDANCE

- Only those students will be eligible to appear in examination who have attended not less than 80% classes in each subject. Attendance in practical classes must be 90%.
- In case of unavoidable absence on medical grounds, leave application must include medical certificate.
- A warning letter is sent to the parents / guardians in case of irregular attendances of their sons / wards.
- In all cases leave taken will be at student's own risk so far as percentage of attendance is concerned.
- Irregularity in classes is punishable at the following rate: (according to the seriousness of the case)

FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS

- a) Absentee from class (Rs. 20/- to 30/-)
- b) Absentee from one practical (Rs. 30/- to Rs. 50/-)
- c) Absentee for one day (Rs. 50/- to Rs. 100/-)

FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

- a) Absentee for one day (Rs. 20 to 50/-)
- b) Absentee from one practical (Rs. 20 to 50/-)





CONDUCT & BEHAVIOUR

AES has an efficiently managed cafeteria with hygienic and affordable food items for the students.



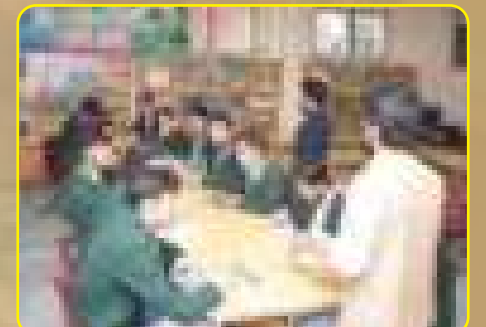
INTERNETWORKING

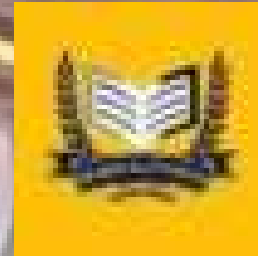


GAMES & SPORTS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING Discipline

To maintain disciplinary standard in the campus, the proctorial board plays a major role. The board is headed by a chief proctor and comprises of a number of students proctors. All the students are expected to achieve a high standard of self-discipline in the campus.

- Proctors have the authority to check students and inform staff proctors if a student is found breaking school/college rules.
- Students must come in proper and complete school /college uniform.
- Maximum of 1-5-minute concession may be given to a student who comes late to the school/college. Students coming very late is not allowed to enter the school/college. Habitual late comers shall be fined and punished.
- Half-day leave is not allowed except in an urgency or emergency. Any student having urgent work / appointment with the doctor. Students going to attend the Funeral should apply for the whole day leave.
- Leave is normally discouraged except for illness and other special reasons. Leave application must be countersigned by parent and submitted one day before the 1st period is over.
- Students who are absent from the school/college for 6 consecutive days without intimation to the school/college will be struck off the school/college rolls.
- Students will not leave the school/college premises without permission of the Principal. They will be issued a card signed by the Principal that shall be deposited with the gate keeper. They must come back within the time allowed to them otherwise they will be punished.
- Parents are expected to be very particular to see that their children have immediately returned after school/college hours.



- AMSC does not accept any responsibility or liability whatsoever for any accident, dispute or quarrel that may happen to any student or among the students traveling to or from the school/college.
- Students are not allowed to bring any valuables to the school/college. In case of damage or loss the school/college authorities will not accept any responsibility whatsoever.
- Use of mobile phones during the class is strictly prohibited. Otherwise mobile phone will be taken in the school/college custody and is returned to the parent of the student only with an assurance of no recurrence.
- A student guilty of misconduct, quarreling in the class within the premises and misbehaviour with any staff member shall face very serious action against him that may be the suspension or expulsion from the college and heavy fine, unchallengeable in any court of law.
- A student found destroying the good name and repute of the institution shall no more remain the college student. There shall be no compromise in this regard.
- Students must maintain cleanliness and proper use of articles in the college. A student guilty of damaging the school property will have to pay for the damage with fine.
- Running, un-necessarily shouting bitterly, abusing other inside the college building, writing, and pasting posters on the college walls are all strictly prohibited.
- Students are expected to cooperate with fellow students and be obedient to their lecturers, staff members.
- Parents must ensure that the study hours of their children are fixed and regularly and properly spent.
- Parents are advised to keep constant contact with the administration regarding attendance and progress of their children.
- In case of migration the dues of the whole session have to be deposited by students.

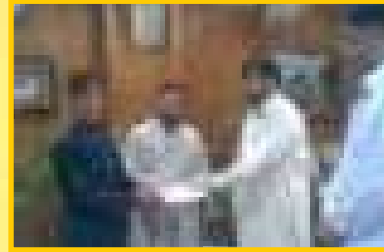

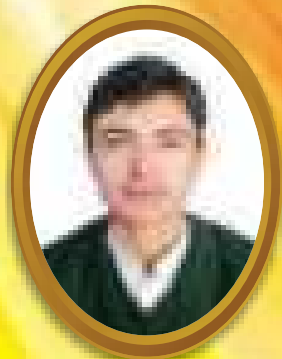

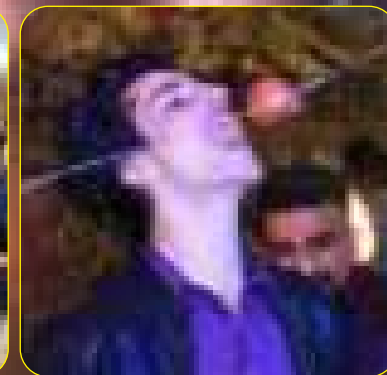
